Gamma Alpha Chapter primarily consists of women educators from Wayne-Westland and Livonia schools. Gamma Alpha engages in projects that support the community. We award one or two \$1,000 Grant-in-Aid funds for early career educators for continuing education or classroom projects. Five hundred dollars is presented to the awardee at our spring dinner. The awardee is encouraged to bring a female teaching colleague to the dinner. Meals will be provided by Gamma Alpha. The remainder of the grant, \$500, will be awarded at one of the fall meetings the awardee chooses to attend. The awardee will give a brief talk about how she has utilized the grant.
